4) Principals Report:

- -Volleyball has started and is running on Mondays and Wednesdays. Mandy Thoohan and Craig Scodellaro are coaching.

5) Treasurers Report: (Linda)

- -Expenses: BCCPAC membership renewal at a cost of \$75 and the Terry Fox Run cost for popsicles: \$67.03

8) Open Forum:
